- *Election of Chairman. Cllr Mrs Wilson, was elected unopposed by bloc vote and signed the declaration opf acceptance of office.*

- 4 Chairmans' Report. Mrs Wilson reported on an uneventful year; the phone box library is open for residents' use; the PC support it by covering insurance costs. The bench is installed on the green and used by both residents and visitors Plans are in hand to purchase a grit bin for the area of the parish near Birdingbury Bridge, and a dog bin for the top of Cooks Lane. The General Data Protection Regulations come into effect shortly, and once known, the position of Data Protection Officer will either be "in house" or by subscription to a commercial firm. She concluded by thanking her colleagues for their support.
- 5 Treasurers' Report. Mrs Fennell said that when VAT reclaim, and an unpresented cheque were credited to the income, it exactly matched the outgoings at £5250.New audit regulations have come into force and the parish council is able to DECLARE ITSELF EXEMPT FROM EXTERNAL AUDIT BY VIRTUE OF TURNOVER UNDER £25,000. This RESOLUTION was proposed by Cllr Gardner, seconded by Cllr Mrs Wilson. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 6 The parish council RESOLVED to approve the annual governance statement from the internal auditor. Proposed by Cllr Mrs Doherty, seconded by Cllr Thompson, CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 7 All members had received a copy of the accounts. It was RESOLVED to approve the accounts. Proposed by Cllr Mrs Wilson, seconded by Cllr Mitchell. CARRIWED UNABNIMOUSLY.
